

2017 TJRA Important Information

1. ENTRIES:

MEMBERS: The February 4th & 5th rodeo, TJRA members will NOT be allowed to call in or walk up and enter without paying a \$25.00 late fee, as with all other rodeos, entry fees must be paid when pre-entering. Entry fee checks will not be cashed until the Monday after the rodeo. A call in will be available the Monday before each rodeo for TJRA members. Remember, if you call in a \$25.00 late fee will be charged.

NON MEMBERS: May call in the Monday prior to the rodeo or enter at the rodeo 1 hour prior to the rodeo start time with a \$10 per day non-member fee.

Call in for the February rodeos will be Monday, January 30th will be from 5:30p – 9:00p. For all other rodeos call in will be 7:00p – 9:00p.

2. Each member will be required to sell \$100.00 in raffles. You will receive your tickets at the first rodeo. You may also print them off the website.
3. All contestants, while in the arena must be in official dress code.
4. At all rodeos that the TJRA is responsible for the concession stand, members are required to bring a 12 pack of Coke, Sprite, Dr. Pepper, etc., hot dog buns, bottled water or any baked goods.
5. Returned check policy: There will now be a \$35 returned check fee. All returned checks must be paid in cash at the following rodeo as well as the entry fee for that rodeo before your child or children will be allowed to compete. In the event of a second returned check the remaining rodeos will be required to be paid in cash or money order for the remaining rodeo season.
6. Draw outs: Draw outs must be done by contacting rodeo secretary by 6:00pm on the Wednesday before the rodeo. Any time after Wednesday you MUST have a written doctor or vet release or it will be consider a turn out and entry fees will not be rolled over or refunded.
7. In the event of a question or concern during an event PARENTS MUST GO TO AN EVENT DIRECTOR IN THE ARENA IMMEDIATELY, not the judge.
8. Church services will be at 8:00am on Sunday before the rodeo for those who wish to attend.
9. All events will run at their regular time at each rodeo.
10. All rough stock riders (including Mutton Bustin) are required to wear a helmet, protective vest and mouth piece, excluding pony bareback. Please read the rule book.
