

# 2018 TJRA Important Information

## 1. ENTRIES:

**MEMBERS:** The February 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> rodeos, TJRA members will not be allowed to call in or walk up and enter WITHOUT paying a \$25.00 late fee, as with all of rodeos. Entry fees must be paid when pre-entering. Entry fee checks will not be cashed until the Monday after the rodeo. The first rodeo postmark is January 22<sup>nd</sup>. All entries must be postmarked two Mondays prior to the rodeo you are entering. A call in will be available the Monday before each rodeo for TJRA members. Remember, if you call in a \$25.00 late fee will be charged.

**NON MEMBERS:** may call in the Monday prior to the rodeo or enter at the rodeo 1 hour prior to the rodeo start time. There will be a \$10.00 non-member fee for each rodeo. Call in for the February rodeos will be Monday, February 5<sup>th</sup> will be from 6:00 – 9:00. For all other rodeos call in will be 7:00 – 9:00.

2. Each member will be required to sell \$100.00 worth of raffle tickets for a 4 man Striper Fishing trip at Lake Texoma.
3. Any TJRA member that sells \$500 or more of the required raffle will be given a 2019 TJRA membership. Also, for each \$100 sold over the required \$100 the member's name will be put in a drawing for a 2019 membership.
4. All contestants, while in the arena must be in official dress code.
5. Returned check policy: All returned checks must be paid in cash at the following rodeo as well as the entry fee for that rodeo before your child or children will be allowed to compete. In the event of a second returned check the remaining rodeos will be required to pay in cash or money order for the remaining of the rodeo season.
6. Draw outs: Draw outs must be done by contacting rodeo secretary by 6:00pm on the Wednesday before the rodeo. Any time after Wednesday you MUST have a written doctor or vet release or it will be consider a turn out and entry fees will not be rolled over or refunded.
7. In the event of a question or concern during an event PARENTS MUST GO TO AN EVENT DIRECTOR IN THE ARENA IMMEDIATELY, not the judge.
8. Church services will be at 8:00am on Sunday before the rodeo for those who wish to attend.
9. All events will run at their regular time at each rodeo.
10. All rough stock riders (including Mutton Bustin) are required to wear a helmet, protective vest and mouth piece, excluding pony bareback. Please refer to the rule book referring to the pony bareback riding equipment.

11. **FORMS:** included in your membership packet is only one entry form and one membership form. If you have more than one child please make as many copies you will need. Also, I need one entry form for **EACH RODEO**. Many times only one form is filled out and only one Admin Fee is paid.
12. **RULE CHANGES:**
  - All 11 – 14 events will be Co-ed except the Boys and Girls Breakaway and Goats. These two events will remain as is.
  - Please read Rules 21 and 24. The wording has been changed.
  - Run off rule
  - Helmets may be worn in all events.
